GNS3 and SolarWinds October Community Mission Sweepstakes: Official Rules

No Purchase Necessary. A Purchase Will Not Increase Your Chances of Winning.

- 1. Eligibility. Under these Official Rules, the GNS3 and SolarWinds October Community Mission Sweepstakes (the "Sweepstakes") is open only to legal residents of Canada (excluding Quebec), the United Kingdom, and the United States (excluding Rhode Island) who are eighteen (18) years of age or older. How to Enter.** Download a free trial of GNS® and SolarWinds® Solar-PuTTY from the Sponsor's websites and submit a screenshot of a topology using GNS3 and Solar-PuTTY to the blog post on https://gns3.com/ to receive one (1) entry into the Sweepstakes drawing. There is a limit of one (1) entry per person and valid business e-mail address. Any entries attempted through the use of agencies or robotic, repetitive, automatic, programmed, or similar methods will be void.
- 6. Drawings.

Grand Prize Drawing: On November 1, 2018, Sponsor will select one (1) potential winner in a random drawing of all entries received during the Entry Period to win the grand prize.

Runner-up Drawing: On November 1, 2018, Sponsor will select three (3) potential winners in a random drawing of all entries received during the Entry Period to win the runner-up prize.

The odds of being selected depend on the number of eligible entries received from all participants for the applicable drawing in connection with this Sweepstakes. The Sponsor will attempt to notify the potential winners within seven (7) days of the drawing.
